## AI-DS WORKING GROUP MEETING 23 APRIL 2026

Time: CEST 9.30 – 12.30 on Thursday 23 April 2026

Venue: Virtual (online)

### Agenda

1. Opening of the meeting and introduction of new members. Introduction also to the AI agent present in the meeting, aiding the proceedings of the group (Jonas)

As the report is on its final stages there will be fairly extensive reporting on the status of the work. Especial emphasis on understanding the input from non-actuarial stakeholders (good reading on this from Finance Watch, see [Protecting EU consumers in the age of AI-driven retail finance | Finance Watch](#)).
6. General outreach
  - feedback on our webinar on behalf of the ProfC on 13 April.
  - ECA 2026 in June – submission(s) sent and approved of, need to plan.
  - [AI knowledge hub](#) – Claudio to present a concept for a lightweight, curated and browsable AI content repository for members, complementary to a newsletter format; discussion and next steps (Claudio).
7. Workstreams
  - use cases – Jonas and Simon to report on progress
  - discrimination – Esko to report on work to be started with representatives of different AAE Committees
  - role of the actuarial function and role of actuaries in how to align vertical rules with AI governance according to the AI Act
  - agentic AI – to discuss the impact of agentic AI on organisations from a risk management perspective and to seek volunteers for further work on this topic (Bogdan).

  - actuarial science often not as sexy as, say, quantitative finance – how to promote the role of actuaries, emotionalising what actuaries do.

  - how to organise work so that we will do essential things while not duplicating what is done in the IAA
